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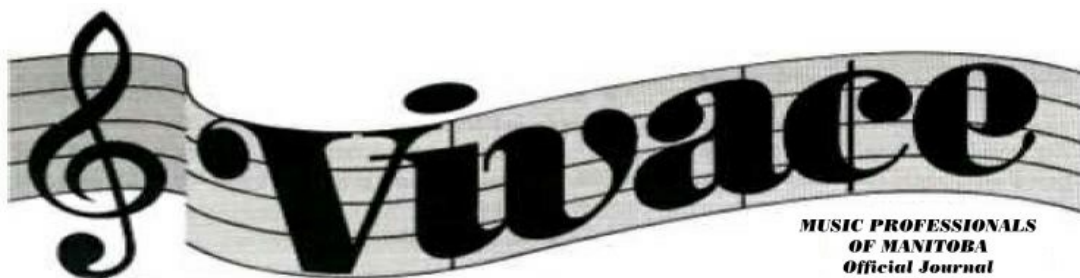

Agenda: Vote on Rates (to become effective January 1, 2025)

Notice of Board Recommendations

Motion #1: Increase all rates 2.5% to the nearest .25 except for #7 Coffee Houses/Book Stores and where otherwise indicated below.

Motion #2: Page 5 OUT OF TOWN ENGAGEMENTS - Add "one way only". For all engagements outside the member's regional area a mileage charge (one way only) of \$.62/km for use of member's vehicle shall be made when transportation not provided.

Motion #3: Page 6 DOUBLING - Add "Solo". Solo/Lead Trumpet 20%

Motion #4: Page 6 DOUBLING - Add "For doubling rates on local subscription theatre engagements, see #6 THEATRICAL PRODUCTIONS & SHOWS, for applicable percentages"

Motion #5: Page 7 CONTRACTOR - Increase Fees 25%. New wording under Minimum fees: "Playing Contractor – musician's minimum basic fee plus 125%. Non-playing contractor – musician's minimum basic fee plus 25%"

Motion #6: Page 9 P2 TEMPORARY WORK PERMIT TO U.S. – Increase \$460 to \$510, \$120 to \$125, \$46.50 to \$50.00

Motion #7: Page 12 & 13 INSTRUMENTAL ACCOMPANIST – Delete tariff 4c) Recitalist and Accompanist for Recitalist

Motion #8: Page 13 BALLET AND DANCE STUDIO RECITALS - Delete "refer to office". Add Performance Accompanist – For one hour or less \$92.25 (no leader or single musician fee). Rehearsal Accompanist – There shall be an intermission of 10 minutes per hour. No rehearsal shall continue for more than 1 ½ hours without an intermission. Partial hours, after the minimum call, are to be pro-rated in 15-minute segments. \$43.25 per hour. Minimum call 2 hours (no leader or single musician fee)

Motion #9: Page 14 THEATRICAL PRODUCTIONS AND SHOWS - Add Solo/Principal trumpet – plus 20%

Motion #10: Page 14 THEATRICAL PRODUCTIONS AND SHOWS - Add "When performing on local subscription theatre productions, musicians required to play more than one instrument shall be paid an additional amount equal to twenty-five percent (25%) of the basic minimum fee for the first "double" and fifteen percent (15%) for each subsequent double."

Motion #11: Page 15 MISCELLANEOUS ENGAGEMENTS - 9b) In Licensed Clubs/Lounges/Restaurants - Increase to \$40/hour

Motion #12: Page 15 MISCELLANEOUS ENGAGEMENTS - Delete tariff 9c) Big Bands in Licensed Clubs

Motion #13: Page 16 ORCHESTRAS 10b) Other (Miscellaneous) - Add Non-playing librarian musician's minimum basic fee

Motion #14: Page 16 ORCHESTRAS 10b) Other (Miscellaneous) - Change Bass to Double Bass

In Memoriam

Elsie Chrunk 1934-2024

On January 30th, 2024, after a brief battle with a subdural hematoma, Elsie passed away peacefully at home.

Elsie started her musical career as a violinist, later switching to the viola. Her musical career with the Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra spanned over 52 years. She was also a member of the CBC Winnipeg Orchestra, a founding member of the Manitoba Chamber Orchestra in 1972, and a regular in the pit of Rainbow Stage, right from their very first production in 1955—Brigadoon.

Elsie will be missed by her many friends and colleagues.
